

River Tummel Trout & Grayling Fishing Directions

The beat extends from within Pitlochry downstream to Ballinluig. Designated parking places, which anglers should use, are provided to allow access from either bank. The Tummel is wide and fast flowing and we would strongly recommend against anglers attempting to wade across the river to fish from the opposite bank.

Access is generally easier from the left bank. From the right bank, there is often a longer walk in and the unclassified road that provides access is sometimes high above the river, with a steep bank to negotiate.

Atholl Estates does not allow trout and grayling permit holders vehicular access across the railway level crossing at Moulinearn.
