Covid Guidelines for Boat Fishing (updated 1 June 2021) until further notice.

The permit holder is responsible for compliance by all in his/her party with these guidelines which are provided to ensure Covid safe access.

Anglers fishing on club waters should be familiar with and continue to follow the five principles behind the Scottish Government's FACTS campaign:

- **F** – wear a Face covering
- **A** – Avoid crowded places
- **C** – Clean hands and surfaces regularly
- **T** – stay Two metre distance away from other people
- **S** – Self-isolate and book a test if you have COVID-19 symptoms (new continuous cough, fever or loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste)

Anglers are required to always comply with current Covid regulations and guidelines issued by the Scottish Government which take precedence over anything contained in these guidelines.

The Club will provide disinfectant surface spray for anglers' use. Containers should be returned with the keys. The Club will also provide disposable gloves (inside the fishing huts) for use during sanitisation.

Anglers and their guests must carry and apply suitable hand sanitiser for their own use to ensure their own safety.

- a) Boats are restricted to a single daily boat turn and must be booked in advance using the Club's online booking system.
- b) Unless from the same household, access to fishing huts is restricted to one person for access to oars and while inside, the door should be left open to increase ventilation.
- c) Surfaces that may have been touched by others (door handles, oars, locks, chains, engines and any parts of the boats likely to be touched etc) should be sanitised before and after use.
- d) Unless from the same household, equipment used (e.g. nets, drogues, oars etc) should not be shared.

Keys for lochs.

Keys and sanitising spray must be collected from Craigdarroch, 15 Toberargan Road, Pitlochry PH16 5HG between 9:00 and 10:00 hrs on the day of fishing. A separate box is provided for each loch, please make sure that you collect the correct keys (bank or boat fishing)! You must have a spare copy of the permit with you to leave in the box so that we know who has collected the keys. **KEYS MUST BE RETURNED BY 21:00 hrs on the day of fishing.** Any queries please contact the Club mobile 07541404048. Huts are locked and must not be used apart from the exception above.
